Volunteer Job Description: CAST Transporter/Server

Interfaith Coalition is a community of many faiths, skills, and backgrounds working together to eliminate homelessness and poverty in Whatcom County. Our member congregations collaborate to fill gaps in human services and to meet housing and other needs of marginalized people.

Position Description: Load, transport, unload, and set up food, drink, and supplies, and then serving and visiting with guests. Large vehicle is needed for this position. Volunteer must have driver's license and valid Whatcom County food handler's permit. There is no proselytizing allowed at CAST, but we encourage friendliness, warmth, smiles, and caring!

Approximate time commitment: 2 – 2.5 hours each shift, one shift per month. Requesting a minimum of 6-month commitment for this volunteer position.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Load and unload food, drinks, and supplies at prep and serving locations
- Track volunteer attendance, number of people served, and supplies to be restocked
- Clean up serving site, including sweeping, picking up trash, and discarding garbage
- Put away food, drinks, supplies after serving and ensure prep site is clean at the end of the shift
- If unable to work your shift, volunteer is responsible for finding and scheduling their own sub

Helpful to have Skills/Qualifications for this position:

- Ability to lift up to 20 lbs
- Ability to stand for one hour
- Willingness to serve in all kinds of weather with no shelter
- Good communication skills
- Comfortable talking with people of various backgrounds, identities, and interests

Volunteer Requirements

- Valid Driver's License and Automobile insurance policy
- Food Handler's Permit
